This list is not intended to be all-inclusive. The right of refusal remains with Goodwill SWPA.

We Accept*:

- Clothing, shoes, accessories and linens
- Saleable kitchen ware, dishes, pans
- Knick knacks and decorative items
- Books, records, CD's, DVD's, cassettes
- Small household appliances (ie. toasters, coffee makers, blenders etc.)
- Tools
- Computer accessories, such as keyboards, mice

We Cannot Accept:

- Baby cribs
- Automobile/truck parts of any kind
- Car seats for infants/children
- Playpens & baby walkers
- Building materials
- Accordion style baby gates
- Storm windows and storm doors
- Large furniture
- Outdoor swing sets
- Bean bag chairs
- All major appliances
- Televisions
- Hospital beds
- Hot water & propane heaters
- Chemicals of any kind (engine oil)
- Gas appliance of any kind
- Firearms & ammunition
- Lamps without a polarized plug
- Safety helmets (used)
